

INFORMATION ON THE USE OF COOKIES

Uses completely anonymous technical cookies on its website www.finomnia.com, as well as third-party cookies (Google Analytics) to monitor visits, always in aggregate form. For information on the use of cookies and their classification, please consult the specific provision adopted by the Italian Data Protection Authority at the following address:

In particular, this provision establishes that for so-called "technical cookies" (which are defined in the provision as "those used for the sole purpose of carrying out the transmission of a communication over an electronic communications network, or to the extent strictly necessary for the provider of an information society service explicitly requested by the contractor or user to provide such service"), it is not necessary to request prior consent, but that extensive and detailed information on how to manage and disable them is sufficient and necessary.

HOW TO PREVENT THE USE OF COOKIES AND DISABLE THEM

If you disable cookies, you will no longer be able to use some of the functions necessary for browsing. Please note that you can disable cookies on your computer at any time by changing your browser settings. The methods depend on the browser used and are described in its help menu. Below are the options for enabling/disabling cookies for the most popular browsers:

INTERNET EXPLORER

Menu: Tools/Internet Options "Privacy" tab, then "Sites": in Website Address, enter the complete address (URL) of the website whose privacy settings you want to customize: To authorize the recording of cookies from the website in question on your computer, click Authorize; To prevent the recording of cookies from the website in question on your computer, click Block.

CHROME

Click the settings icon on the browser toolbar: Settings; Click View Advanced Settings. In the "Privacy" section, click Content Settings. In the "Cookies" section, you can change the following settings: Delete cookies, Block cookies by default, Allow cookies by default, and Allow cookies from certain websites or domains.

FIREFOX

Click Tools and then Options. Privacy tab: under "Firefox will:" select "Use custom settings for history." Check the "Accept cookies" box and click "Exceptions" to choose which websites to allow or deny from storing cookies on your device.

OPERA

Preferences > Advanced > Cookies Cookie preferences allow you to control how Opera handles cookies. The default setting is to accept all cookies.

GOOGLE ANALYTICS
